Evanston, IL – The non-profit visual arts group Anatomically Correct presents the **Second Annual Evanston Art Walk**, a juried art exhibition of artwork by Illinois artists displayed in storefront windows along Central Street in Evanston, Illinois during the month of October 2009.

Festivities include a **Benefit/Silent Auction/Award Ceremony** at **Symphony's Cafe, 1945 Central Street** on **Thursday, October 1, 2009 (7 - 9 pm)**. Tickets are \$20/person and can be purchased in advance through Anatomically Correct, 312-514-1802.

The ***Outstanding Contributions to the Arts Award*** will be presented to Evanston resident, **Joanna Pinsky**, Founder/Artistic Director of **Art Encounter**, an Evanston nonprofit visual art education organization founded in 1978.
