## Ann Rosen

Ann Rosen recently retired after 17½ years as Executive Director of The Art Center Highland Park. During her tenure the center flourished moving three times to larger facilities culminating in its present location 1957 Sheridan. Each move resulted in increased participation by artists and the general public. Before coming to the center, Ann exhibited her own paintings and was an educator teaching art to adults and children in the public schools. Her educational background from The Graduate School of the Art Institute and the Univ. of IL plus her volunteer experiences inspired a dedication of nurturing the art experience in the local community. Ann accomplished this by initiating multi level art classes, cultural programs and professional gallery exhibits. A frequent juror and curator for art exhibits she values a close association with area artists and art administrators. In her retirement Ann looks forward to having more time to do her own art work, volunteering and continuing her involvement with the arts and her community.

## Cheryl Steiger

Ann Rosen's award is created by Cheryl Steiger. Highland Park resident Cheryl Steiger attended the American Academy of Art in Chicago. Ms. Steiger is a free-lance commercial artist, fine artist and is also an art instructor to students of all ages. Some of her classes are held regularly at The Art Center in Highland Park, Evanston Art Center, and The Park in Vernon Hills. She continues to do commissions and shows her artwork nationally.

## Nancie King Mertz, Juror

Nancie received a BFA in Painting from the University of Illinois – Urbana: a MA in Painting, from Eastern Illinois University – Charleston (also a 3 year Faculty Instructor of Art.) She has studied privately with American masters: Schmid, Silverman, Shapiro, Gerhartz, Burdick, Aspevig, Daily and Auster. Her award-winning work has graced magazine covers & catalogs, has been featured in national art magazines, and published as posters for many Chicago fund-raising events. Pure Color: The Best of Pastel & Best of America Pastels are books recently released that include her work. She is a member of the Oil Painters of America, Chicago Plein Air Painters, and a signature member of Pastel Society of America and Chicago Pastel Painters. Nancie is owner of ArtDeTriumph & Artful Framers Studios, a custom framing and fine art studio, est. 1979. She was named "Artist of the Year 2005-2006 & 2006-2007" by the Chicago Convention & Tourism Bureau and "Business Person of the Year 2008" by Chicago's Lincoln Park Chamber of Commerce.
